



## **Off-Campus Event Registration**

Off-Campus events with alcohol at the event should complete the <u>Presence form</u>. The form requests information about the event, as well as a risk management plan.

Once the Presence submission is reviewed the Chapter President and Alumnae/i advisor will receive a document for e-signature. The process is not an approval of the event, but rather the chapter sharing details of the event and affirming acknowledgement of relevant policy and process. The form needs to be submitted <u>3 weeks before the event date</u>.

- Any event where alcohol is planned to be present must be registered with a completed Attestation form (sent through Adobe for an e-signature for the Chapter President & Advisor)
- Events submitted less than 3 weeks are out of compliance with our policy.
- Encourage submission of any events planned (e.g., formals)
