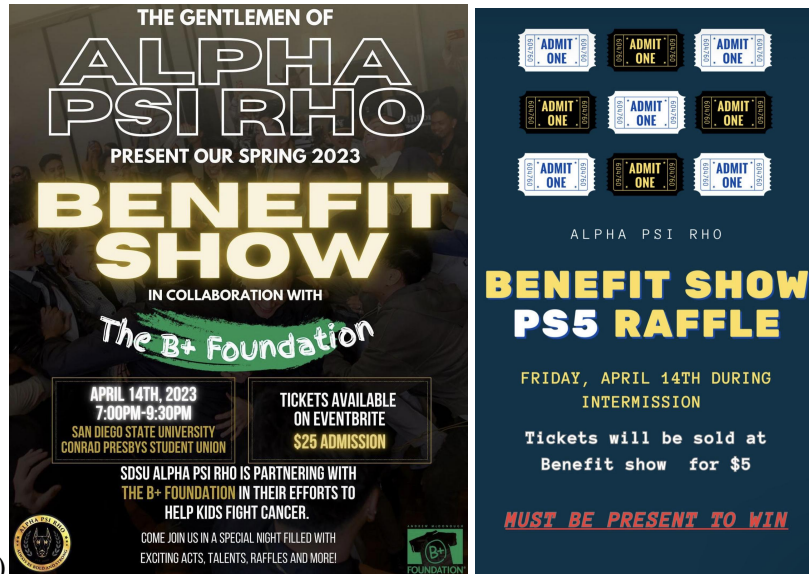

All chapters partaking in these events will be expected to submit an attendance list of their actives to the College Panhellenic Association.”

Bylaw Change:

- “Panhellenic chapter members are encouraged to attend Aztec Night events with the exception of the event(s) held exclusively for first year SDSU students as determined by the University, specifically the Templo Del Sol Aztec Night event held the first Friday following residential hall move-ins. All active

members partaking in these events are required to wear their specific chapter affiliated/Greek Organization attire. Conversations must reflect positive Panhellenic contact. Follow an active-PNM ratio of no more than three (3) active members per one (1) PNM. All chapters partaking in these events will be expected to submit an attendance list of their actives to the College Panhellenic Association at least 3 days prior to Aztec Nights being held.”
